Setup & Operation Instructions

ICOtec GC350 Electronic Game Call

Add Batteries - Open battery panel with phillip screw driver, place 4 new AA batteries as indicated, close panel and replace screw. Lithium for best results in cold weather is recommended.

Turn Power Switch On - Slide switch to the on position, a red LED indicator will appear if unit is on. If it does not light up, open panel and be sure all batteries are new and in proper position.

Raise Antenna - Place antenna in upright position on main unit.

Select Prey Call - Raise antenna on remote control and press button of desired call sound. All supplied calls cycle through a pattern of natural pauses. Your unit will play several seconds (20 - 40) and then go silent 30 seconds and then play again indefinitely until you select stop. This is to eliminate the need for you to select stop and start several times per set.

Adjust Volume - Press volume up arrow for louder or down arrow for quieter.

End Calls - Press STOP.

Synchronizing Remote to Unit

Your ICOtec remote can be reprogrammed to work with your base unit if it happens to become unresponsive or if you lose your remote and purchase a new one form ICOtec. Simply press and hold the reset button on the left of the "ON/OFF" switch of the base with a paperclip, then press and hold any sound button on the remote unit for three seconds. Note: If you turn the unit on and there is no SD Card in the slot, the unit will verbally alert you to insert SD Card, we recommend shutting the power off prior to inserting the card.

Trouble Shooting

Unit does not play calls - Be sure batteries are NEW from the store, not a drawer, and are installed properly, if you press a call button on the remote and the green LED light blinks or does not light up, you need to replace the 23A battery in the remote. Remove the screw to the battery door, remove, dispose of battery properly and replace as indicated.

Programming New Sound Files:

- 1. On your computer, locate all of the files you plan to load onto the GC350 and place them in a new folder and name it "GC350 New Sounds". This is for organizational purposes only, you can choose to do what best suits you. Be sure all .wav files are 16 bit or lower.
- 2. You will need to rename your files to fall in the order you want them. Begin with 001 add a space and then the call name. You have up to 21 characters total which includes the file number. Once you have renamed all of the files you plan to program into the GC350 you are ready to copy them over to the call.

001 = call button 1/13 in A mode, 013 = call button 1/13 in B mode.

- 3. Use the provided USB cable to connect the GC350 to your computer. Once the unit is plugged into the computer you may turn the power on. You will see an external drive appear on your computer screen. It will appear under the Computer Drives on a PC and a drive icon will appear on your screen if you are using a MAC.
- 4. Open the drive and go to the folder where all of your sound files will need to be placed. We recommend using a new SD Card for new sound files and copying all of the provided calls to a GC350 Sounds Backup folder on your computer so you will not lose them if you happen to delete them from your SD Card.
- 5. Now that the calls are named and numbered, you will need to copy them to your "GC350 New Sounds" folder. We recommend that you purchase a new SD Card for the new sound files and remove the disk that came with the unit to preserve the files should vou decide to use them in the future.
- 6. Once you have renamed all of the files and you are satisfied with the numbering order, copy all of the files into the folder on the GC350 SD Card.
- 7. When the files are finished copying you may select eject and unplug the unit from your computer. Turn unit off, wait 3 seconds and turn back on, you are ready to call.

We recommend that you remove and insert SD Card while unit is OFF. This unit does not play 24 bit .wav files.
